- Enrolled members must select a network primary care physician (PCP)—either a general or family practitioner, internist or pediatrician—from the Advocate Health Care network, or a network PCP will be selected for them.
- PCPs will provide care for the majority of a member's health care needs, whether it be for a preventive visit or an illness or injury, as well as provide a referral when specialist care is needed.
- Out-of-network coverage is not available except in the case of emergency care.
- Members must obtain a referral from their designated PCPs before they see any other network physician or specialist.

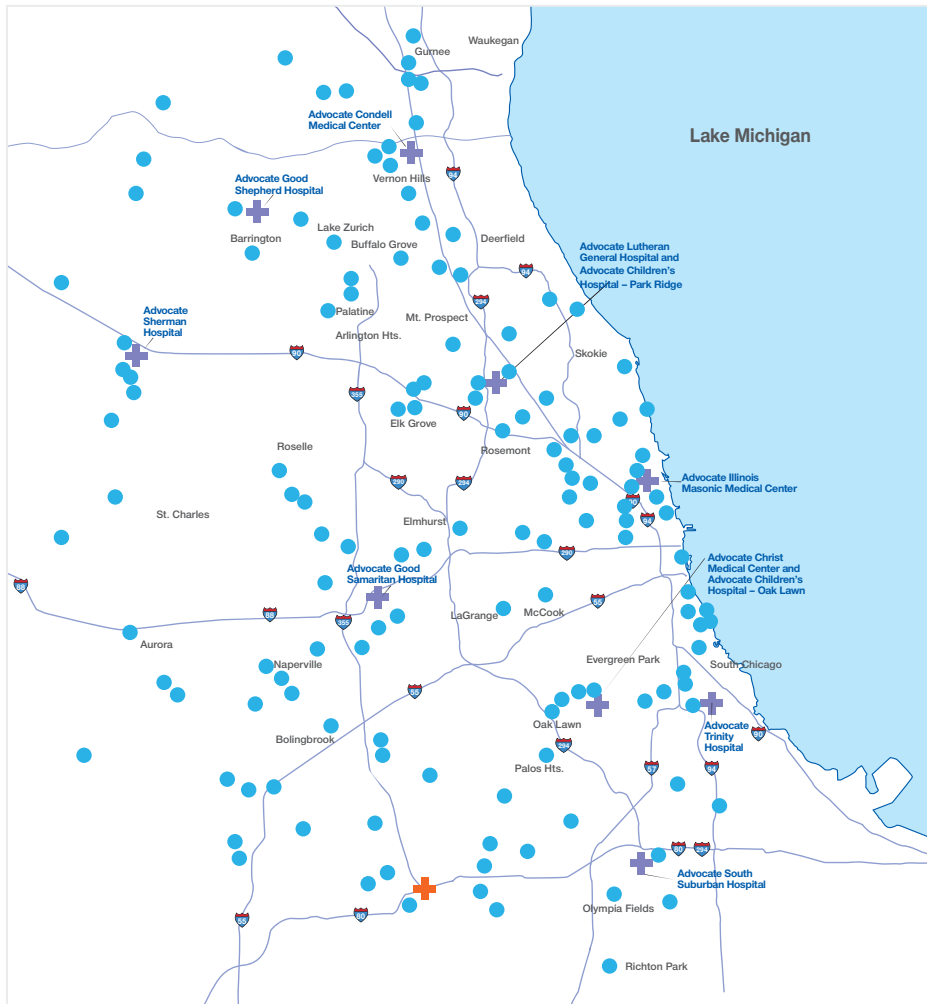
